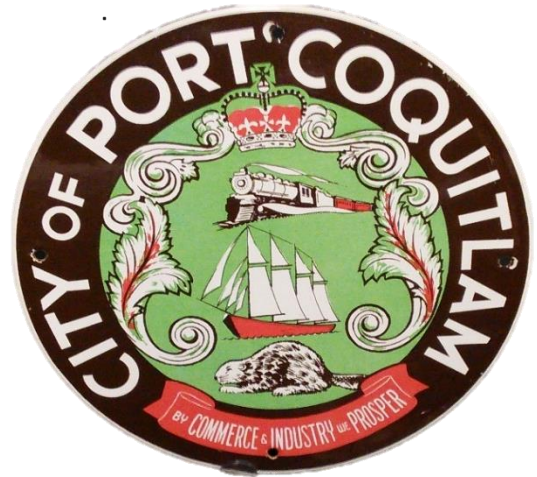

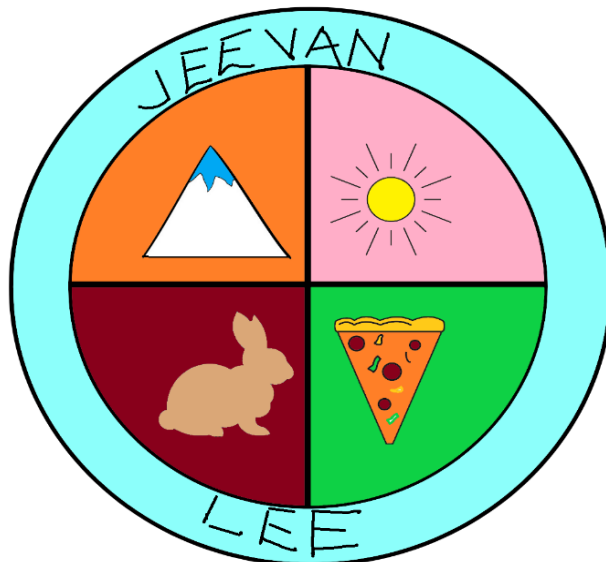
MY “COAT OF ARMS” ACTIVITY!

Write your name in _____ the outside circle.

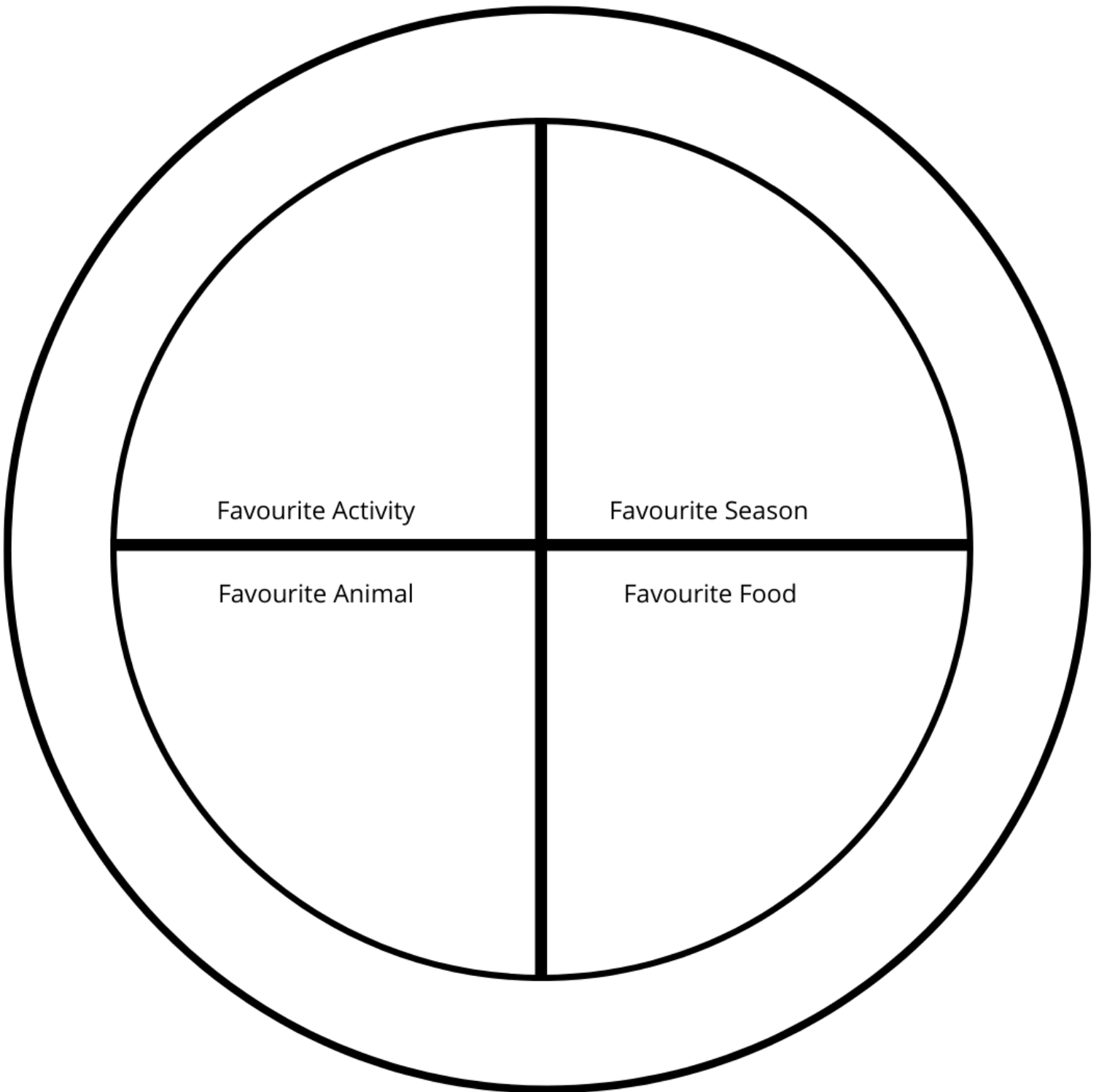


Example:
